Excellence Charter School for Girls: Proposed location is NYC CSD 16 (Brooklyn) with a planned opening in fall of 2009; 1st year proposed enrollment/grades served - 116 students/K-1; 5th year proposed enrollment/grades served - 319 students/K-5; Charter management organization – Uncommon Schools, Inc.

Leadership Preparatory East New York Charter School: Proposed location is NYC CSD 19 (Brooklyn) with a planned opening in fall of 2009; 1st year proposed enrollment/grades served - 116 students/K-1; 5th year proposed enrollment/grades served - 319 students/K-5; Charter management organization – Uncommon Schools, Inc.

Leadership Preparatory Flatbush Charter School: Proposed location is NYC CSD 17 (Brooklyn) with a planned opening in fall of 2010; 1st year proposed enrollment/grades served - 116 students/K-1; 5th year proposed enrollment/grades served - 319 students/K-5; Charter management organization – Uncommon Schools, Inc.

Leadership Preparatory Brownsville Charter School: Proposed location is NYC CSD 23 (Brooklyn) with a planned opening in fall of 2010; 1st year proposed enrollment/grades served - 116 students/K-1; 5th year proposed enrollment/grades served - 319 students/K-5; Charter management organization – Uncommon Schools, Inc.

Coney Island Preparatory Charter School: Proposed location is NYC CSD 21 (Brooklyn) with a planned opening in fall of 2009; 1st year proposed enrollment/grades served - 100 students/5; 5th year proposed enrollment/grades served - 471 students/5-9.

Brooklyn Prospect Charter School: Proposed location is NYC CSD 15 (Brooklyn) with a planned opening in fall of 2009; 1st year proposed enrollment/grades served - 100 students/6; 5th year proposed enrollment/grades served - 491 students/6-10.
