**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that pursuant to Education Law subdivision 2857(1) and prior notices, the Board of Trustees of the State University of New York (the “SUNY Trustees”) may approve the resubmission (with or without modifications) to the Board of Regents of the following proposed charter at the meeting of the SUNY Trustees’ Charter Schools Committee scheduled for January 15, 2010. (The Charter Schools Committee has been delegated authority from the SUNY Trustees to handle resubmissions). Such action is contingent upon the Board of Regents voting on January 12, 2010 to return the proposed charter to the SUNY Trustees. If the Board of Regents approves the application, a separate notice regarding same will be provided.

- **University Preparatory Charter School for Young Men:** Proposed location is Rochester City School District with a planned opening in September 2010; 1<sup>st</sup> year proposed enrollment/grades served - 150 students/grades 7-8; 5<sup>th</sup> year proposed enrollment/grades served - 450 students/grades 7-12;
