PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that pursuant to Education Law subdivision 2857(1), the Board of Trustees of the State University of New York (the "State University Trustees") in its capacity as a charter authorizer approved the following renewal applications at the State University Trustees' Charter Schools Committee meeting held on January 15, 2010:

- **Leadership Village Academy Charter School:** Located at 2351 First Avenue, 4th Floor, New York 10035, in CSD 4; granted a 5-year charter renewal commencing on August 1, 2010; proposed 1st year enrollment/grades served - 324 students/5-10; proposed 5th year enrollment/grades served - 433 students/5-12.
- **Amber Charter School:** Located at 220 East 106th Street, New York, NY 10029, in CSD 4; granted a 5-year charter renewal commencing on July 1, 2010; proposed 1st year enrollment/grades served - 425 students/K-5; proposed 5th year enrollment/grades served - 425 students/K-5.
- **Bronx Preparatory Charter School:** Located at 3872 Third Avenue, Bronx, NY 10457, in CSD 9; granted a 5-year charter renewal commencing on July 1, 2010; proposed 1st year enrollment/grades served - 701 students/5-12; proposed 5th year enrollment/grades served - 701 students/5-12.
- **Harlem Link Charter School:** Located at 20 West 112th St., New York, NY 10026, in CSD 3; granted a 3-year charter renewal commencing on August 1, 2010; proposed 1st year enrollment/grades served - 320 students/K-5; proposed 3rd year enrollment/grades served - 320 students/K-5.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the State University Trustees will forward the proposed renewal charters to the Board of Regents for approval or comment.
