- **Achievement Academy Charter School:** Located at 42 South Dove Street, First Floor, Albany, NY, the school seeks a 5-year charter renewal commencing on August 1, 2010; proposed 1<sup>st</sup> Year enrollment/grades served - 260 students/5-8; proposed 5<sup>th</sup> Year enrollment/grades served - 260 students/5-8.
- **Albany Preparatory Charter School:** Located at 50 Summit Avenue, Albany, NY, the school seeks a 3-year charter renewal commencing on July 1, 2010; proposed 1<sup>st</sup> Year enrollment/grades served - 230 students/5-8; proposed 3<sup>rd</sup> Year enrollment/grades served - 230 students/5-8.
