PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that pursuant to Education Law subdivision 2857(1) and its prior notification the Board of Trustees of the State University of New York (the "State University Trustees") in its capacity as a charter authorizer approved the following new application for a charter school on January 27, 2009:

- **Albany Leadership Charter High School for Girls:** Proposed location is Albany City School District with a planned opening in August 2010; 1st year proposed enrollment/grades served - 125 students/grade 9; 5th year proposed enrollment/grades served - 375 students/grades 9-12.

The State University Trustees will enter into a proposed charter with the school listed above and will forward it to the Board of Regents for approval or comment.
