PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that pursuant to Education Law subdivision 2857(1), the Board of Trustees of the State University of New York (the "State University Trustees") in its capacity as a charter authorizer has received the following charter renewal applications for the following charter schools within the last 30 days:

- **Oracle Charter School:** Located at 888 Delaware Avenue, Buffalo, New York, the school seeks a 3-year charter renewal commencing August 1, 2010; proposed 1st Year enrollment/grades served - 360 students/9-12; proposed 3rd Year enrollment/grades served - 360 students/9-12.
- **South Buffalo Charter School:** Located at 2219 South Park Avenue, Buffalo, New York, the school seeks a 5-year charter renewal commencing on July 1, 2010; proposed 1st Year enrollment/grades served - 669 students/K-8; proposed 5th Year enrollment/grades served - 900 students/K-8.
