PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that pursuant to Education Law subdivision 2857(1) and its prior notification the Board of Trustees of the State University of New York (the "State University Trustees") in its capacity as a charter authorizer will likely consider the following proposed charter renewal at its March 27, 2009 meeting:

- **New Covenant Charter School:** Located at 50 North Lark Street, Albany, NY 12210; the school seeks a 5 year charter renewal commencing on September 18, 2009 and terminating on July 31, 2010; proposed 1st Year enrollment/grades served - 625 students/K-6; proposed 5th Year enrollment/grades served - 625 students/K-6.

On January 27, 2009, the State University Trustees voted to have the renewal application reviewed by the full SUNY Board, thereby tabling the prior action of the Charter Schools Committee.
