Pursuant to the Charter Schools Institute's prior notice letters and Education Law subdivision 2857(1), this Notice is to inform you that the Charter Schools Committee of the Board of Trustees of the State University of New York (the "State University Trustees"), acting on behalf of the State University Trustees, voted to resubmit to the Board of Regents without modifications the following proposed renewal charters at its meeting on November 12, 2009:

- **Leadership Preparatory Charter School:** Located at 600 Lafayette Avenue, Brooklyn, New York 11216, NYC CSD 13; charter renewal commencing December 1, 2010 and terminating July 31, 2011; proposed final enrollment/grades served – 396 students/K-5.
- **Grand Concourse Academy Charter School:** Located at 116-118 East 169th Street, Bronx, NY 10452-7704; in CSD 9, Region 1; the school seeks a 5 year charter renewal commencing on July 31, 2009; proposed 1st Year enrollment/grades served - 364 students/K-5; proposed 5th Year enrollment/grades served - 356 students/K-5.
- **Bronx Charter School for Excellence:** Located at 1960 Benedict Avenue, Bronx, NY 10462; in CSD 11, Region 2; ; the school seeks a 5 year charter renewal commencing on July 31, 2009; proposed 1st Year enrollment/grades served - 300 students/K-5; proposed 5th Year enrollment/grades served - 300 students/K-5.

Pursuant to subdivision 2852(5-b) of the Education Law, the State University Trustees resubmitted the proposed renewal charters to the Board of Regents on November 13, 2009 for its review and comment. If the Board of Regents does not approve the proposed renewal charters within 30 days after the date of resubmission, the proposed renewal charters will be issued by operation of law. We anticipate no further notices regarding the issuance of these renewal charters.
