Pursuant to the Charter Schools Institute's prior notice letters, this Notice, pursuant to Education Law subdivision 2857(1), is to inform you that the Charter Schools Committee of the Board of Trustees of the State University of New York (the "State University Trustees"), acting on behalf of the State University Trustees, voted to resubmit to the Board of Regents without modifications the following proposed charters at its meeting on January 16, 2009:

- **Crown Heights Collegiate Charter School:** Proposed location is CSD 23 with a planned opening in August 2010; 2nd year proposed enrollment/grades served - 78 students/grade 5; 5th year proposed enrollment/grades served - 208 students/grades 5-7; charter management organization - Uncommon Schools, Inc.
- **East New York Collegiate Charter School:** Proposed location is CSD 23 with a planned opening in August 2010; 2nd year proposed enrollment/grades served - 78 students/grade 5; 5th year proposed enrollment/grades served - 208 students/grades 5-7; charter management organization - Uncommon Schools, Inc.
- **Flatbush Collegiate Charter School:** Proposed location is CSD 17 with a planned opening in August 2009; 1st year proposed enrollment/grades served - 78 students/grade 5; 5th year proposed enrollment/grades served - 263 students/grades 5-8; charter management organization - Uncommon Schools, Inc.
- **Girls Preparatory Charter School of East Harlem:** Proposed location is CSD 4 with a planned opening in August 2009; 1st year proposed enrollment/grades served - 144 students/K-1; 5th year proposed enrollment/grades served - 390 students/K-4.

Pursuant to subdivision 2852(5-b) of the Education Law, the State University Trustees resubmitted the proposed charters to the Board of Regents on January 21, 2009 for its review and comment. If the Board of Regents does not approve the proposed charters within 30 days after the date

of resubmission, the proposed charters will be issued by operation of law. We anticipate no further notices regarding the issuance of these charters.
