PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that pursuant to Education Law subdivision 2857 (1), the Board of Trustees of the State University of New York (the "SUNY Trustees") in its capacity as a charter authorizer has received the following new applications for charter schools:

- **True North Genesee Preparatory Charter School:** Proposed location is Rochester City School District with a planned opening in August 2011; 1st year proposed enrollment/grades served - 78 students/grade 5; 5th year proposed enrollment/grades served - 594 students/K-3 and 5-8.
- **Rochester Career Mentoring Charter School:** Proposed location is Rochester City School District with a planned opening in September 2011; 1st year proposed enrollment/grades served - 140 students/9-10; 5th year proposed enrollment/grades served - 280 students/9-12.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE THAT the SUNY Trustees may consider approval of the above proposed charters as soon as 45 days from the date hereof, but have scheduled consideration of them for a meeting to be held during May of 2010.
