PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that pursuant to Education Law subdivision 2857(1) and its prior notification the Board of Trustees of the State University of New York (the "State University Trustees") in its capacity as a charter authorizer approved the following new applications for charter schools on September 16, 2008.

- **Girls Preparatory Charter School of East Harlem:** Proposed location is CSD 4 with a planned opening in August 2009; 1st year proposed enrollment/grades served - 144 students/K-1; 5th year proposed enrollment/grades served - 390 students/K-4.
- **Carl C. Icahn Charter School NINE:** Proposed location is CSD 8 with a planned opening in September 2009; 1st year proposed enrollment/grades served - 108 students/K-2; 5th year proposed enrollment/grades served - 252 students/K-5.
- **Flatbush Collegiate Charter School:** Proposed location is CSD 17 with a planned opening in August 2009; 1st year proposed enrollment/grades served - 78 students/grade 5; 5th year proposed enrollment/grades served - 263 students/grades 5-8; charter management organization - Uncommon Schools, Inc.
- **Crown Heights Collegiate Charter School:** Proposed location is CSD 23 with a planned opening in August 2010; 2nd year proposed enrollment/grades served - 78 students/grade 5; 5th year proposed enrollment/grades served - 208 students/grades 5-7; charter management organization - Uncommon Schools, Inc.
- **East New York Collegiate Charter School:** Proposed location is CSD 23 with a planned opening in August 2010; 2nd year proposed enrollment/grades served - 78 students/grade 5; 5th year proposed enrollment/grades served - 208 students/grades 5-7; charter management organization - Uncommon Schools, Inc.

The State University Trustees will enter into proposed charters for each school listed above and will forward them to the Board of Regents for approval or comment.
