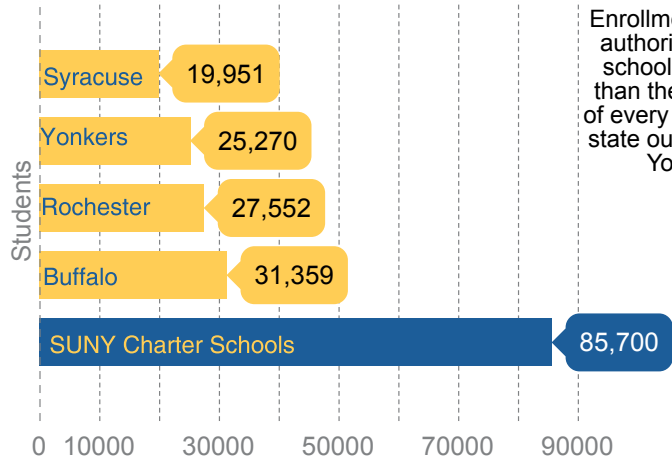
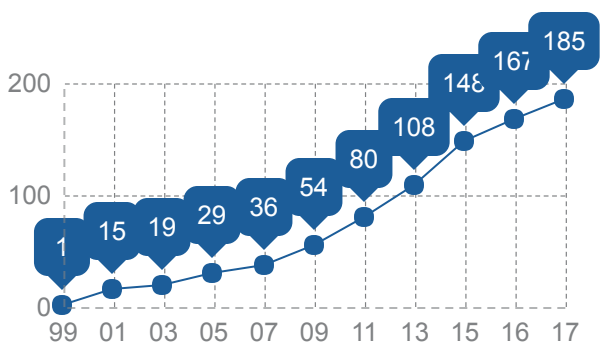


Fast Facts SUNY Authorized Charter Schools

35,000 students are waiting for a seat in a SUNY authorized charter school.

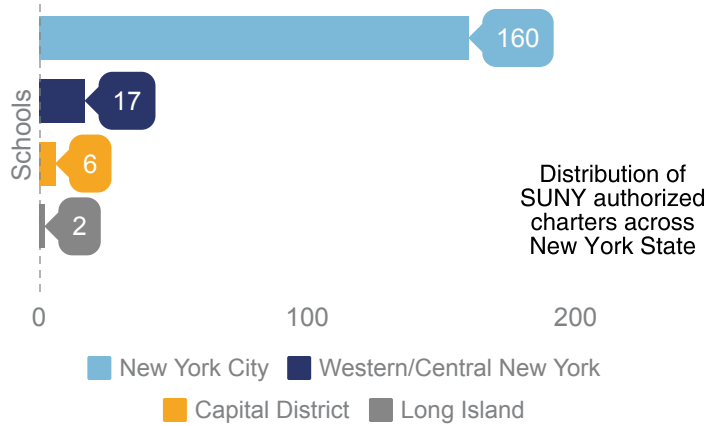
75% of SUNY authorized charter school students are economically disadvantaged.

5% of SUNY authorized charter school students are English language learners.

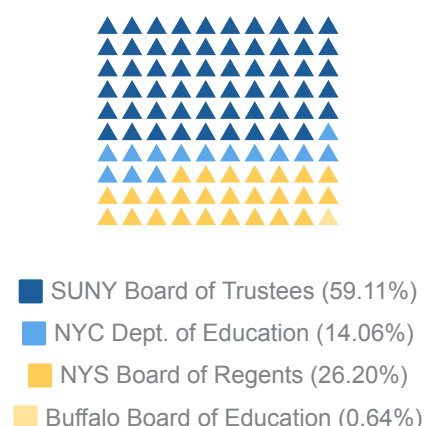
14% of SUNY authorized charter school students are students with disabilities.

9% of SUNY authorized charter schools have not been renewed by the SUNY Board of Trustees.

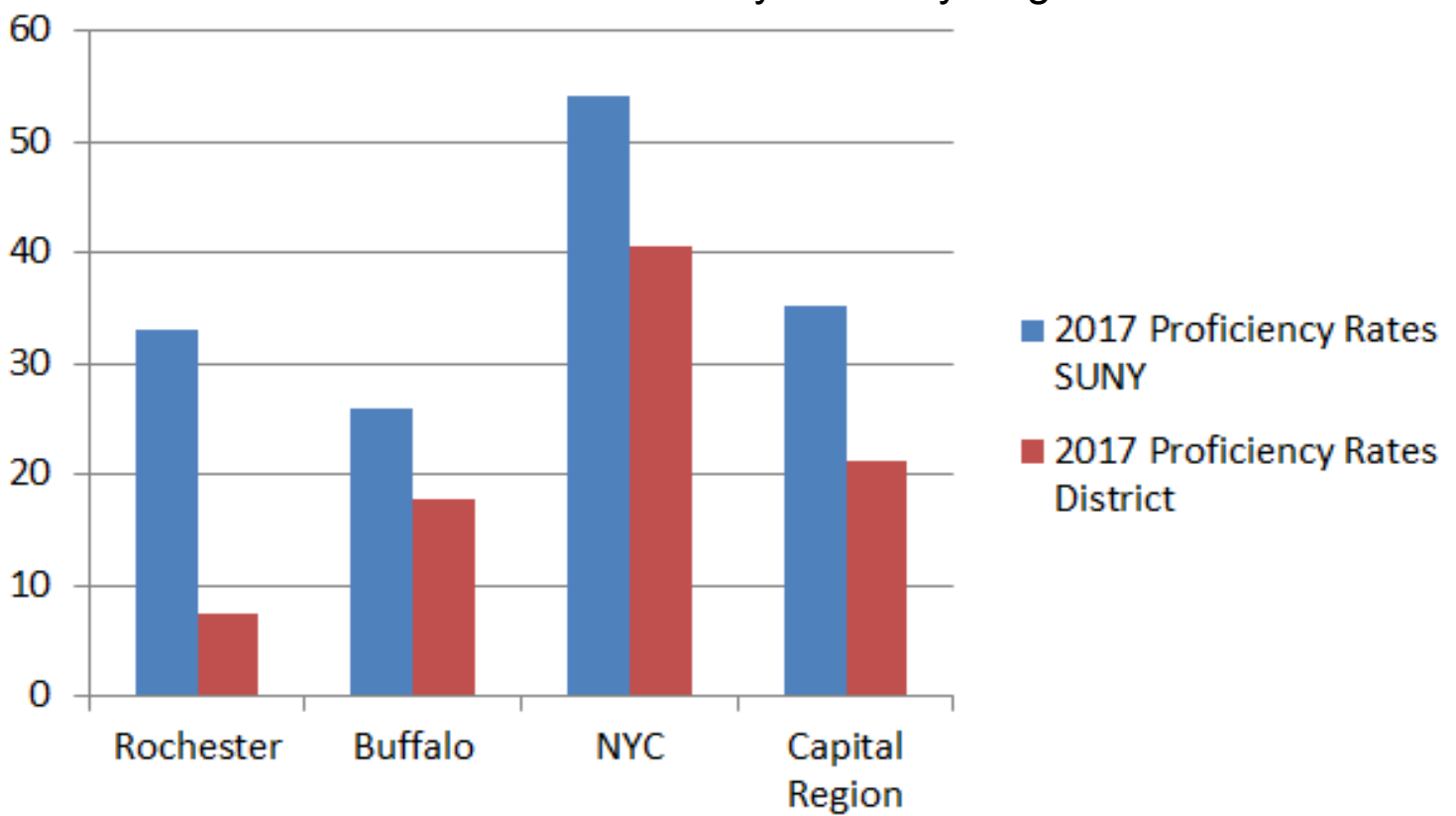


SUNY is the largest authorizer of charter schools in New York State.
