**SUBJECT: First Notice of Charter Revision - Receipt**

**DATE: March 3, 2021**

This Notice is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, has received applications to revise the charters of the charter schools listed below. Further, the SUNY Trustees, or their designees, the SUNY Charter Schools Committee or SUNY Charter Schools Institute (the "Institute"), anticipate consideration of these requests as soon May 1, 2021. A description of the proposed actions are as follows:

- **Atmosphere Academy Public Charter Schools**, located at 5959 Broadway, 22 Marble Hill Avenue, and 3700 Independence Avenue, Bronx, NY 10463 in Community School District ("CSD") 10, is currently authorized to serve 600 students in grades 6-8 through the 2024-25 school year, the last year of the current charter term. The school requests to increase enrollment by 60 students across grades 6-8 starting in the 2022-23 school year and to add a high school program starting in the 2022-23 school with 320 additional students in grades 9-10. The school proposes to add one grade each year for a total of 640 additional students in grades 9-12. The school's total chartered enrollment would be 1,300 students by the 2024-25 school year.
- **International Leadership Charter High School**, located at 3030 Riverdale Avenue, Bronx, NY 10463 in CSD 10, is currently authorized to serve 420 students in grades 9-12 for the 2022-23 school year through the 2024-25 school year, the last year of the current charter term. The school requests to add a middle school program starting in the 2022-23 school year with 100 additional students in the 6<sup>th</sup> grade and adding a grade each year for a total of 300 additional students in grades 6-8. The school's total chartered enrollment would be 720 students for the 2024-25 school year.
