SUBJECT: Second Notice of Charter Renewals – SUNY Trustee Approval

DATE: April 22, 2021

This updated Notice, pursuant to New York Education Law § 2857(1), is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the “SUNY Trustees”), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, approved the following charter renewal requests:

- **KIPP: Albany Community Public Charter Schools**, an education corporation operating more than one school, seeks to renew its authority to operate the following charter school:
 - **Albany Community Charter School**, located at 65 Krank Street and 42 South Dove Street, Albany, NY 12202 in the Albany City School District, chartered to serve 675 students in grades K-8 seeks a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2021. According to the renewal application the school will grow to serve 743 students in grades K-8. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the renewal application on or about August 17, 2020; and, 2) approved a five year renewal on or about March 17, 2021.
- **Green Tech Charter School**, located at 99 Slingerland Street, Albany, NY 12202 in the Albany City School District, chartered to serve 440 students in grades 6-7, 9-12 seeks a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2021. According to the renewal application the school will grow to serve 505 students in grades 6-12. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the renewal application on or about August 17, 2020; and, 2) approved a five year renewal on or about February 24, 2021.

Please take further Notice that the SUNY Trustees have sent or will send the proposed renewal charters to the Board of Regents for approval or action consent with the New York Charter Schools Act of 1998.
