This Notice is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, has received the following applications to renew the charters or authority to operate of the charter schools listed below. Further, the SUNY Trustees, or their designees, the SUNY Charter Schools Committee, anticipate consideration of these applications as soon as November 1, 2021. A description of the proposed actions follows:

- **Elmwood Village Charter Schools**, an education corporation with the authority to operate more than one school, seeks to renew its authority to operate the following charter school
  - **Elmwood Village Charter School Hertel**, located at 665 Hertel Avenue, Buffalo, NY 14207 in the Buffalo City School District, chartered to serve 350 students in grades K-6, seeks a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2022. According to the renewal application, the school will grow to serve 450 students in grades K-8.
