SUBJECT: Final Notice of Charter Renewal – Operation of Law

DATE: July 13, 2022

This final Notice, pursuant to New York Education Law §2857(1), is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the “SUNY Trustees”), in its capacity as a charter authorizer approved the renewal applications for the charter schools listed below, sent the materials to the New York State Board of Regents (“Board of Regents”), and the renewal has been approved by operation of law in accordance with the New York Charter Schools Act of 1998 (the “Act”). As the Act requires no further action, this will be the last notice on this item. A description of the action is as follows:

Elmwood Village Charter Schools, an education corporation with the authority to operate more than one school, seeks to renew its authority to operate the following charter school

- **Elmwood Village Charter School Hertel**, located at 665 Hertel Avenue, Buffalo, NY 14207 in the Buffalo City School District, chartered to serve 350 students in grades K-6, sought a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2022. According to the renewal application, the school will grow to serve 450 students in grades K-8.

The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the renewal application on or about August 16, 2021; and, 2) approved the renewal on or about March 17, 2022; and, 3) the renewal was approved by operation of law on July 11, 2022.
