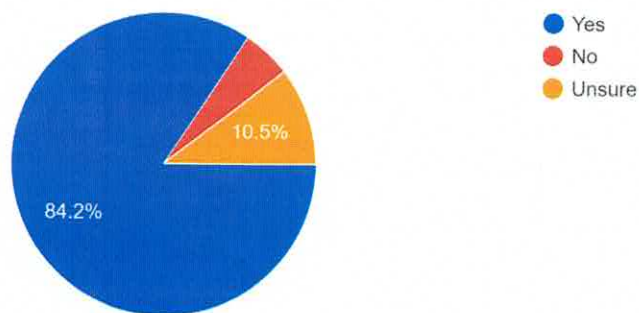

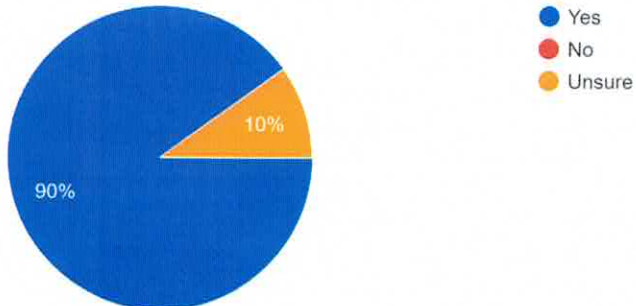

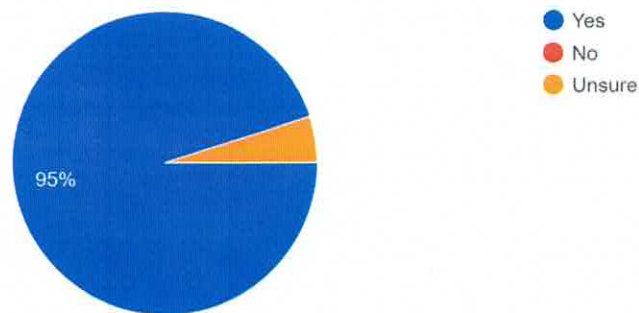
Would you be in favor of longer school hours for students?

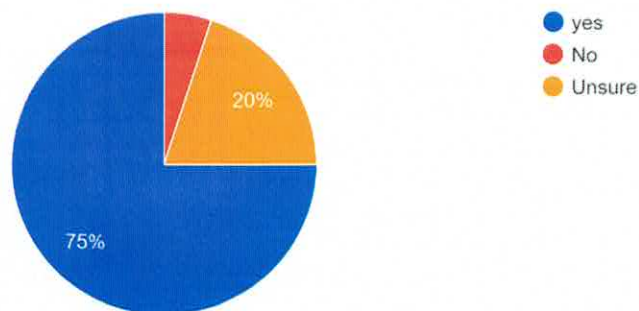
