**SUBJECT: Notice of Receipt and Pending Action on Charter Revision Applications**

This Notice is to inform you that the Board of Trustees of the State University of New York (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as a charter authorizer has received applications to revise the charters of the charter schools listed below. Further, the SUNY Trustees, or their designee, the SUNY Charter Schools Institute, anticipates consideration of these requests on or about June 4, 2014.

Descriptions of the proposed actions follow:

- **Achievement First Brownsville Charter School**, the education corporation that operates **Achievement First North Brooklyn Prep Charter School** (formerly "Achievement First Central Brooklyn Charter School"), located at 35 Starr Street, Brooklyn, New York 11221 in Community School District ("CSD") 32, and scheduled to open in Fall of 2013, has requested to postpone opening the school until fall of 2014 with grade 5 and grow to grades K-8 by the end of the current charter term with the goal of ultimately operating grades K-12. The corporation has now requested that the school open with grades K-1 and grow to grades K-5 by the end of the current charter term with the same ultimate K-12 goal. This enrollment model aligns with more recent schools managed by Achievement First, Inc.
- **Achievement First – Bushwick Charter School**, the education corporation that operates **Brooklyn Academy Charter School**, which is scheduled to open in the fall of 2014 at 800 Van Siclen Avenue, Brooklyn, New York 11207 in CSD 19, requests to change the school's legal name to "Achievement First Linden Charter School."
