This Notice is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as a charter authorizer has received applications to revise the charter(s) of the charter school(s) listed below. Further, the SUNY Trustees, or their designee, the SUNY Charter Schools Institute (the "Institute"), anticipates consideration of this request as soon March 11, 2015.

A description of the proposed actions follows:

Achievement First-Bushwick Charter School, an existing not-for-profit charter school education corporation authorized by SUNY with the authority to operate:

- **Achievement First-Bushwick Charter School**, located at 125 Covert Street, Brooklyn, NY 11207, 1300 Greene Avenue, Brooklyn, NY 11237 in Community School District ("CSD") 32 and 1785 Pacific Street, Brooklyn, NY 11216 in CSD 16, currently serving approximately 965 students in grades K-12;
- **Achievement First Linden Charter School**, located at 800 Van Siclen Avenue, Brooklyn, NY 11207 in CSD 19, currently serving approximately 180 students in grades K-1;
- **Achievement First Charter School 10**, to be located in CSDs 16, 17, 23 or 32 opening in the Fall of 2015 with approximately 180 students in grades K-1;
- **Achievement First Charter School 11**, to be located in CSDs 16, 17, 23 or 32 opening in the Fall of 2016 with approximately 180 students in grades K-1; and,
- **Achievement First Charter School 12**, to be located in CSDs 16, 17, 23 or 32 opening in the Fall of 2015 with approximately 92 students in grade 5;

proposes to merge with the following education corporations:

- **Achievement First Brownsville Charter School**, an existing not-for-profit charter school education corporation authorized by SUNY with the authority to operate:
 - **Achievement First Brownsville Charter School**, located 2021 Bergen Street, Brooklyn, NY 11233 in CSD 23, currently serving approximately 665 students in grades K-7; and
 - **Achievement First North Brooklyn Preparatory Charter School**, located 200 Woodbine Street, Brooklyn, NY 11221 in CSD 32, currently serving approximately 180 students in grades K-1;
- **Achievement First Apollo Charter School**, an existing not-for-profit charter school education corporation authorized by SUNY located at 350 Linwood Street, Brooklyn, NY 11208 in CSD 19, currently serving approximately 504 students in grades K-5; and,
- **Achievement First Aspire Charter School**, an existing not-for-profit charter school education corporation authorized by SUNY located at 982 Hegeman Avenue, Brooklyn, NY 11208 in CSD 19, currently serving approximately 249 students in grades K-2;

such that if the merger is approved, Achievement First-Bushwick Charter School would be the successor education corporation under the name “Achievement First Brooklyn Charter Schools.” The proposed merger would be effective July 1, 2015, or as soon thereafter as practicable at the close of a fiscal quarter. Each education corporation other than Achievement First Bushwick-Charter School seeks a revision to its charter to permit it to merge with Achievement First-Bushwick Charter School; and, Achievement First-Bushwick Charter School seeks permission to merge with each other education corporation.

Please take further Notice that the SUNY Trustees will send the proposed revisions to the Board of Regents for approval or action consistent with the New York Charter Schools Act of 1998.
