This Notice is to inform you that the Board of Trustees of the State University of New York (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as a charter authorizer has received applications to revise the charters of the SUNY authorized charter school education corporations listed below. Further, the SUNY Trustees, or their designee, the SUNY Trustees' Charter Schools Committee, anticipates consideration of this application as soon as June 4, 2014. - **Community Partnership Charter School**, an existing charter school located at 241 Emerson Place, Brooklyn, New York 11205 in Community District ("CSD") 13, currently serves 450 students in grades K-8, and proposes to merge with **Beginning with Children Charter School II**, an existing charter school located at 214 Heyward Street, Brooklyn, New York 11206 in CSD 14, which currently serves 150 students in grades K-2. If the merger is approved, Community Partnership Charter School would be the successor education corporation under the new corporate name "Community Partnership Charter School Education Corporation." Following the merger, the schools would continue under their current names. Each education corporation seeks a revision to its charter to permit it to merge with the other education corporation. The proposed merger would be effective July 1, 2014, or at the beginning of the next succeeding fiscal quarter after final approval.
