SUBJECT: Notice of Receipt and Pending Action on Charter Revision Applications

This Notice is to inform you that the Board of Trustees of the State University of New York (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as a charter authorizer has received applications to revise the charters of the not-for-profit charter school education corporations listed below. Further, the SUNY Trustees, or their designee, the SUNY Trustees' Charter Schools Committee, anticipates consideration of this application as soon as June 4, 2014. - **Girls Preparatory Charter School of New York**, an existing charter school located at 442 East Houston Street, New York, NY and 420 East 12th Street, New York, NY 10009 in Community School District ("CSD") 1, currently serves 525 students in grades K-8, and proposes to merge with:
 - **Boys Preparatory Charter School of New York**, a charter school scheduled to open at 1695 Seeward Avenue, Bronx, NY 10473 in CSD 8, which will serve 132 students in grades K-1 in the 2014-15 school year; and
 - **Girls Preparatory Charter School of the Bronx**, an existing charter school located at 681 Kelly Street, Bronx, NY 10455 and 890 Cauldwell Avenue, Bronx, NY 10456 in CSD 8, which currently serves 445 students in grades K-5.

If the merger is approved, Girls Preparatory Charter School of New York would be the successor education corporation under the new corporate name "Public Prep Charter School Academies." Following the merger, the schools would continue under their current names. Each education corporation seeks a revision to its charter to permit it to merge with either Girls Preparatory Charter School of New York, or the other corporations, as appropriate. The proposed merger would be effective July 1, 2014, or at the close of the next succeeding fiscal quarter, whichever occurs first.
