This updated Notice is to inform you that the Board of Trustees of the State University of New York, in its capacity as a charter authorizer, has approved an application to revise the charter of the charter school listed below, sent the revision to the Board of Regents and the revision has been approved by operation of law in accordance with the New York Charter Schools Act of 1998, as amended (the "Act"). As the Act requires no further action, this will be the last notice on this item.

- **Harlem Village Academy Leadership Charter School**, located at 2351 First Avenue and 313 East 120th Street, New York, New York 10035, both in Community School District 4, seeks the addition of an elementary program which would increase current projected enrollment from 362 students in grades 5-11 to 551 students in grades K and 5-12 during the 2012-13 school year, 663 students in grades K-1 and 5-12 during the 2013-14 school year, and 773 students in grades K-2 and 5-12 during the 2014-15 school year. This change will allow implementation of an enrollment at-risk designation by which the first thirty percent of open seats will be saved for students that qualify for the Federal Free and Reduced Price Lunch program. In addition, the education corporation will adjust certain program elements and policies of its school to accommodate the elementary school program.
