This Notice is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, has received application(s) to revise the charter(s) of the charter school(s) listed below. Further, the SUNY Trustees, or their designees, the SUNY Charter Schools Committee or SUNY Charter Schools Institute (the "Institute"), anticipate consideration of this request as soon December 1, 2017.

A description of the proposed actions follows:

- **KIPP Tech Valley Charter School**, located at 321 Northern Blvd, Albany, New York 12210 in the Albany City School District, originally approved to serve 543 students in grades K-2 and 5-8 for the 2017-18 school year, seeks to revise its enrollment to serve approximately 511 students in grades K-1 and 5-8 for the 2017-18 school year. The school had originally been approved to serve 667 students in grades K-8 by the end of the current charter term in 2019-20. The request provides for the school to serve approximately 693 students in grades K-3, 5-8 by the end of the current charter term.
