This third and final Notice, pursuant to New York Education Law § 2857(1), is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the “SUNY Trustees”), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, approved application(s) for the charter school(s) listed below, sent the application(s) to the New York State Board of Regents, and the application(s) have been approved by operation of law in accordance with the New York Charter Schools Act of 1998 (as amended, the “Act”). As the Act requires no further action, this will be the last notice on these items. A description of the application(s) follows:

**Cardinal McCloskey Community Charter School**, to be located in Community School District 10, will serve approximately 150 students in grades K-1 during the 2018-19 school year. At full capacity, the school will serve approximately 450 students in grades K-5. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the application on or about March 13, 2017; 2) approved the application on June 8, 2017; and, 3) the application was approved by operation of law on November 9, 2017.
