This updated Notice is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, approved the revision(s) to the charter(s) of the charter school(s) listed below.

A description of the proposed action(s) follows:

- **PUC Achieve Charter School**, located at 14 Mark Street, Rochester, NY 14605, in the Rochester City School District, currently serving approximately 185 students in grades 5-7, has requested to serve approximately 297 students in grades 5-7 for the 2016-17 school year, 406 students in grades 5-8 for the 2017-18 school year and 420 students in grade 5-8 for the 2018-19 school year, the final year of the current charter term. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the revision application on or about June 29, 2016; and, 2) approved the revision on September 27, 2016.

Please take further Notice that the SUNY Trustees have sent or will send the proposed revision(s) to the Board of Regents for approval or action consistent with the New York Charter Schools Act of 1998.
