This Notice is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, has received applications to revise the charter(s) of the charter school(s) listed below. Further, the SUNY Trustees, or their designees, the SUNY Charter Schools Committee or SUNY Charter Schools Institute (the "Institute"), anticipate consideration of this request as soon February 16, 2017.

A description of the proposed actions follows:

Family Life Academy Charter Schools, which has the authority to operate three schools, requests a revision to allow the middle school program for all schools to be operated by **Family Life Academy Charter School II**, as opposed to all three schools. The schools would change as follows:

- **Family Life Academy Charter School**, located at 14 West 170th Street, Bronx, NY 10452, in CSD 9, currently serving approximately 467 students in grades K-8 was scheduled to serve approximately 168 students in grades K-8 for the 2017-18 school year, the last year of the current charter term, will now serve approximately 312 students in grades K-5.
- **Family Life Academy Charter School III**, located 370 Gerard Avenue, Bronx, NY 10451, in CSD 7, currently serving approximately 200 students in grades K-3, was scheduled to serve approximately 300 students in grades K-5 for the 2018-19 school year, the last year of the current charter term, would now serve approximately 312 students in grades K-4.

Revision to First Notice

Family Life Academy Charter Schools, an education corporation operating more than one school, seeks to renew its authority to operate the following charter school for five years commencing on August 1, 2017:

- **Family Life Academy Charter School II**, located at 296 E. 140th Street, Bronx, NY 10454, in CSD 7, currently serving approximately 300 students in grades K-5, seeks to grow to serve approximately 884 students in grades K-8.
