This Notice is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, has received an application(s) to revise the charter(s) of the charter school(s) listed below. Further, the SUNY Trustees, or their designee, the SUNY Charter Schools Institute (the "Institute"), anticipates consideration of these requests as soon as May 1, 2015.

Description(s) of the proposed action(s) follow:

- **Canarsie Ascend Charter School**, located at 9719 Flatlands Avenue, Brooklyn, NY 11212, in Community School District ("CSD") 18, currently serving approximately 249 students in grades K-2; and,
- **Central Brooklyn Ascend Charter School**, located at 1501 Pitkin Avenue, Brooklyn, NY 11212 in CSD 14, currently serving approximately 208 students in grades K-1, both request to change the schools' curriculum from the SABIS curriculum to the Ascend Common Core Curriculum to allow further alignment to the Common Core standards.
