This Notice is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, has received an application(s) to revise the charter(s) of the charter school(s) listed below. Further, the SUNY Trustees, or their designee, the SUNY Charter Schools Institute (the "Institute"), anticipates consideration of this request as soon as May 1, 2015.

Description(s) of the proposed action(s) follow:

- **Manhattan Charter School II**, located at 220 Henry Street, New York, NY 10002, in Community School District 1, currently serving approximately 190 students in grades K-3, requests to expand its grades offered by in the next charter term from K-5 to K-8. SUNY agrees to accept such grade expansion by currently amending the school's charter regarding the terms of the school's renewal application such that the expansion will be contingent upon the school: 1) providing a renewal application with the grade expansion; 2) qualifying for at least a short-term renewal pursuant to the SUNY Renewal Policies; and, 3) being in good standing at such time.
