This first Notice, pursuant to Education Law § 2857(1), is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, has received the following application(s) to renew the charter(s) of or renew the authority to operate, the charter school(s) listed below. The SUNY Trustees, or their Charter Schools Committee, anticipate consideration of these applications as soon as December 12, 2017.

A description of the proposed actions follows:

- **Academic Leadership Charter School**, located at 677 East 141st Street, Bronx, NY 10454 in Community School District ("CSD") 7, currently serving approximately 600 students in grades K-8, seeks a five year renewal of its charter commencing July 1, 2018. According to the renewal application the school will grow to serve approximately 650 students in grades K-8.
- **Coney Island Preparatory Public Charter School**, located at 315 Avenue U, Brooklyn, NY 11223 in CSD 21, currently serving approximately 1,032 students in grades K-12, seeks a five year renewal of its charter commencing July 1, 2018. According to the renewal application, the school will continue to serve approximately 1,032 students in grades K-12.
- **PAVE Academy Charter School**, located at 732 Henry Street, Brooklyn, NY 11231 in CSD 15, currently serving approximately 490 students in grades K-8, seeks a five year renewal of its charter commencing July 1, 2018. According to the renewal application, the school will continue to serve approximately 490 students in grades K-8.
