This Notice is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, has received the following applications to renew the charters of the charter schools listed below. Further, the SUNY Trustees, or their designees, the SUNY Charter Schools Committee, anticipate consideration of these applications as soon as October 30, 2020. A description of the proposed actions follows:

- **KIPP: Albany Community Public Charter Schools**, an education corporation operating more than one school, seeks to renew its authority to operate the following charter school:
  - **Albany Community Charter School**, located at 65 Krank Street and 42 South Dove Street, Albany, NY 12202 in the Albany City School District, chartered to serve 675 students in grades K-8 seeks a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2021. According to the renewal application the school will grow to serve 743 students in grades K-8.
- **Green Tech Charter School**, located at 99 Slingerland Street, Albany, NY 12202 in the Albany City School District, chartered to serve 440 students in grades 6-7, 9-12 seeks a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2021. According to the renewal application the school will grow to serve 505 students in grades 6-12.
