This Notice is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, has received the following application to renew the charter of the charter school listed below. Further, the SUNY Trustees, or their designees, the SUNY Charter Schools Committee, anticipate consideration of this application as soon as September 3, 2019. A description of the proposed action follows:

- **Amber Charter School** (in process to be renamed Amber Charter Schools), an education corporation operating more than one school, seeks to renew its authority to operate the following charter school:
 - **Amber Charter School East Harlem**, located at 220 East 106th Street, New York, NY 10029 in Community School District ("CSD") 4, currently chartered to serve 520 students in grades K-5, seeks a five year renewal of its charter commencing July 1, 2020. According to the renewal application, the school will serve approximately 525 students in grades K-5.
