This Notice is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, has received the following applications to renew the charters of the charter schools listed below. Further, the SUNY Trustees, or their designees, the SUNY Charter Schools Committee, anticipate consideration of these applications as soon as November 1, 2019. A description of the proposed actions follows:

- **Elmwood Village Charter Schools**, an education corporation operating more than one school, seeks to renew its authority to operate the following charter school:
 - **Elmwood Village Charter School Days Park**, located at 40 Days Park, Buffalo, NY 14201 in the Buffalo City School District, chartered to serve 450 students in grades K-8, seeks a five year renewal of its charter commencing on July 1, 2020. According to the renewal application, the school will continue to serve 450 students in grades K-8.
- **South Buffalo Charter School**, located at 154 South Ogden Street, Buffalo, NY 14206 in the Buffalo City School District, chartered to serve 900 students in grades K-8, seeks a five year renewal of its charter commencing on July 1, 2020. According to the renewal application, the school will continue to serve 900 students in grades K-8.
