This Notice is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, has received the following applications to renew the charters of the charter schools listed below. Further, the SUNY Trustees, or their designees, the SUNY Charter Schools Committee, anticipate consideration of these applications as soon as December 21, 2020. A description of the proposed actions follows:

- **Success Academy Charter Schools – NYC**, an education corporation operating more than one school, seeks to renew its authority to operate the following charter schools:
  - **Success Academy Charter School – Bronx 3**, located at 1000 Teller Avenue, Bronx, NY 10456 in Community School District ("CSD") 9 and 965 Longwood Avenue, Bronx, NY 10459 in CSD 8, chartered to serve 840 students in grades K-10 in the 2022-23 school year, the last year of the current charter term, seeks a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2023. According to the renewal application the school will grow to serve 2,148 students in grades K-12.
  - **Success Academy Charter School – Harlem 6**, located at 461 West 131<sup>st</sup> Street, New York, NY 10027 in CSD 5, chartered to serve 1,917 students in grades K-8 in the 2021-22 school year, the final year of the current charter term, seeks a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2022. According to the renewal application the school will serve 727 students in grades K-8.
  - **Success Academy Charter School – Hudson Yards**, located at 500 West 41<sup>st</sup> Street, New York, NY 10036 in CSD 2, chartered to serve 675 students in grades K-5 in the 2021-22 school year, the final year of the current charter term, seeks a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2022.

According to the renewal application the school will serve 367 students in grades K-4.
