This Notice is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, has received the following applications to renew the charters of the charter schools listed below. Further, the SUNY Trustees, or their designees, the SUNY Charter Schools Committee, anticipate consideration of these applications as soon as October 30, 2020. A description of the proposed actions follows:

- **Achievement First Brooklyn Charter Schools**, an education corporation operating more than one school, seeks to renew its authority to operate the following charter school:
 - **Achievement First Voyager Charter School**, located at 601 Parkside Avenue, Brooklyn, NY 11226 in Community School District ("CSD") 17, chartered to serve 240 students in grades 5-8, seeks a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2021. According to the renewal application, the school will continue to serve 240 students in grades 5-8.

- **Amber Charter Schools**, an education corporation operating more than one school, seeks to renew its authority to operate the following charter school:
 - **Amber Charter School Kingsbridge**, located at 3120 Corlear Avenue, Bronx, NY 10463 in CSD 10, chartered to serve 475 students in grades K-5, seeks a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2021. According to the renewal application, the school will grow to serve 875 students in grades K-8.

- **Bronx Charter School for Excellence**, an education corporation operating more than one school, seeks to renew its authority to operate the following charter school:

According to the renewal application the school will serve 328 students in grades 9-12.
- **Capital Prep Charter Schools NY**, an education corporation operating more than one school, seeks to renew its authority to operate the following charter school:
 - **Capital Preparatory Harlem Charter School**, located at 1 East 104th Street, New York, NY 10029 in CSD 4, chartered to serve 400 students in grades 6-11 seeks a five year renewal of its charter commencing July 1, 2021. According to the renewal application, the school will grow to serve 700 students in grades 6-12.
- **Democracy Prep New York Charter Schools**, an education corporation operating more than one school, seeks to renew its authority to operate the following charter school:

- **New Visions Charter High School for Advanced Math and Science**, located at 99 Terrace View Avenue, Bronx, NY 10463 in CSD 10, chartered to serve 566 students in grades 9-12 seeks a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2021. According to the renewal application the school will continue to serve 566 students in grades 9-12.
- **New Visions Charter High School for the Humanities**, located at 99 Terrace View Avenue, Bronx, NY 10463 in CSD 10, chartered to serve 566 students in grades 9-12 seeks a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2021. According to the renewal application the school will continue to serve 566 students in grades 9-12.

- **New York City Charter School of the Arts**, located at 26 Broadway, New York, NY, 10004 in CSD 2, chartered to serve 306 students in grades 6-8 seeks a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2021. According to the renewal application the school will grow to serve 270 students in grades 6-8.
- **Sisulu-Walker Charter School of Harlem**, located at 125 West 115th Street, New York, NY 10026 in CSD 3, chartered to serve 270 students in grades K-5 seeks a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 10, 2021. According to the renewal application the school will serve 240 students in grades K-5.
- **Success Academy Charter Schools – NYC**, an education corporation operating more than one school, seeks to renew its authority to operate the following charter schools:
 - **Success Academy Charter School – Bed Stuy 3**, located at 787 Lafayette Avenue, Brooklyn, NY 11221 in CSD 16, chartered to serve 295 students in grades 5-7, seeks a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2021. According to the renewal application the school will grow to serve 444 students in grades 5-8.
 - **Success Academy Charter School – Harlem 1**, located at 34 West 118th Street, New York, NY 10026, and 215 West 114th Street, New York, NY 11026 in CSD 3 and 111 East 33rd Street, New York, NY 10016 in CSD 2, chartered to serve 1,751 students in grades K-12, seeks a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2021. According to the renewal application the school will grow to serve 1,938 students in grades K-12.
