This Notice is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, has received the following applications to renew the charters of the charter schools listed below. Further, the SUNY Trustees, or their designees, the SUNY Charter Schools Committee, anticipate consideration of these applications as soon as June 11, 2020. A description of the proposed actions follows:

- **True North Rochester Preparatory Charter School**, an education corporation operating more than one school, seeks a five year renewal commencing August 1, 2021 of its charter and its authority to operate the following charter schools all located within the Rochester City School District:
 - **Rochester Preparatory Charter School 3**, located at 85 St. Jacob Street, Rochester, NY 14621, is chartered to serve 576 students in grades K-4 for the 2020-21 school year, the final year of the current charter term. According to the renewal application the school would grow to serve 807 students in grades K-8.
 - **True North Rochester Preparatory Charter School**, located at 899 Jay Street, Rochester, NY 14611, 630 Brooks Avenue, Rochester, New York 14619, and 305 Andrews Street, Rochester, NY 14604, is chartered to serve 1,483 students in grades K-12 for the 2020-21 school year, the final year of the current charter term. According to the renewal application the school would serve 1,405 students in grades K-12.

- **True North Rochester Preparatory Charter School – West Campus**, located at 85 St. Jacob Street, Rochester, NY 14621 and 432 Chili Avenue, Rochester, NY 14611, is chartered to serve 810 students in grades K-8 for the 2020-21 school year, the final year of the current charter term. According to the renewal application the school would serve 807 students in grades K-8.
