This updated Notice, pursuant to New York Education Law § 2857(1), is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the “SUNY Trustees”), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, approved renewal(s) of the charter(s) of the charter school(s) listed below.

Description(s) of the proposed action(s) are as follows:

- **Academic Leadership Charter School**, located at 677 East 141<sup>st</sup> Street, Bronx, NY 10454 in Community School District (“CSD”) 7, currently serving approximately 600 students in grades K-8, seeks a five year renewal of its charter commencing July 1, 2018. According to the renewal application the school will grow to serve approximately 650 students in grades K-8. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the renewal application on or about October 27, 2017; and, 2) approved a five year renewal on April 24, 2018.
- **Achievement First Brooklyn Charter Schools**, an education corporation operating more than one school, seeks to renew its authority to operate the following charter schools:
  - **Achievement First Aspire Charter School**, located at 982 Hegeman Avenue, Brooklyn, NY 11208 in CSD 19, currently serving approximately 456 students in grades K-4, seeks a five year renewal of its authority to operate commencing August 1, 2018. According to the renewal application the school will grow to serve approximately 959 students in grades K-10. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the renewal application on or about August 15, 2017; and, 2) approved a five year renewal on April 24, 2018.

- **Achievement First Brownsville Charter School**, located at 2021 Bergen Street, Brooklyn, NY 11233 and 301 Vermont Street, Brooklyn, NY 11207 in CSDs 23 and 19, respectively, currently serving approximately 883 students in grades K-9, seeks a five year renewal of its authority to operate commencing August 1, 2018. According to the renewal application the school will grow to serve approximately 1,304 students in grades K-12. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the renewal application on or about August 15, 2017; and, 2) approved a five year renewal on April 24, 2018.
- **Achievement First Crown Heights Charter School**, located at 790 East New York Avenue, Brooklyn NY, 11203 and 1485 Pacific Street, Brooklyn, NY 11216, both in CSD 17, currently serving approximately 966 students in grades K-12, seeks a five year renewal of its authority to operate commencing July 1, 2018. According to the renewal application the school will grow to serve approximately 1,304 students in grades K-12. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the renewal application on or about August 15, 2017; and, 2) approved a five year renewal on April 24, 2018.
- **Middle Village Preparatory Charter School**, located at 68-02 Metropolitan Avenue, Middle Village, NY 11379 in CSD 24, currently serving approximately 360 students in grades 6-8, seeks a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2018. According to the renewal application the school will grow to serve 450 students in grades 6-8. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the renewal application on or about August 15, 2017; and, 2) approved a five year renewal on April 24, 2018.
- **University Prep Charter School**, located at 600 St. Ann's Avenue, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, Bronx, NY 10455 in CSD 7, currently serving approximately 385 students in grades 9-12, seeks a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2018. According to the renewal application the school will grow to 400 students in grades 9-12. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the renewal application on or about August 15, 2017; and, 2) approved a five year renewal on April 24, 2018.

Please take further Notice that the SUNY Trustees have or will send the proposed renewal charter(s) to the New York State Board of Regents for approval or action consistent with the New York Charter Schools Act of 1998 (as amended).
