SUBJECT: Third Notice of Charter Renewal(s) – Operation of Law

DATE: November 9, 2018

This third and final Notice, pursuant to New York Education Law § 2857(1), is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the “SUNY Trustees”), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, approved renewal(s) for the charter school(s) listed below, sent the renewal(s) to the New York State Board of Regents, and the renewal(s) have been approved by operation of law in accordance with the New York Charter Schools Act of 1998 (as amended, the “Act”). As the Act requires no further action, this will be the last notice on these items. A description of the renewal(s) follows:

- **King Center Charter School**, located at 156 Newburgh Avenue, Buffalo, NY 14211 in the Buffalo City School District, currently serving approximately 408 students in grades K-8, seeks a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2018. According to the renewal application the school will grow to serve approximately 459 students in grades K-8. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the renewal application on or about August 15, 2017; 2) approved a five year renewal on January 9, 2018; and, 3) the renewal was approved by operation of law on October 18, 2018.
