UPDATED PUBLIC NOTICE

SUBJECT: Second Notice of Charter Renewal(s) – SUNY Trustee Approval

DATE: December 20, 2019

This updated Notice, pursuant to New York Education Law § 2857(1), is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the “SUNY Trustees”), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, approved the applications to renew the charters of or the authority to operate the charter schools listed below:

- **Amber Charter Schools**, an education corporation operating more than one school, sought to renew its authority to operate the following charter school:
 - **Amber Charter School East Harlem**, located at 220 East 106th Street, New York, NY 10029 in Community School District (“CSD”) 4, currently chartered to serve 520 students in grades K-5, sought a five year renewal of its charter commencing July 1, 2020. According to the renewal application, the school will serve approximately 525 students in grades K-5. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the renewal application on or about May 6, 2019; and, 2) approved the renewal application on October 15, 2019.
- **Atmosphere Academy Public Charter Schools**, which operates **Atmosphere Academy Public Charter School**, located at 22 Marble Hill Avenue, Bronx, NY 10463, 5959 Broadway, Bronx, NY 10463 and 3700 Independence Avenue, Bronx, NY 10463 all in CSD 10, chartered to serve 342 students in the grades 6-8, sought a five year renewal of its charter commencing on August 1, 2020. According to the amended renewal application, the school will grow to serve 600 students in grades 6-8. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the renewal application on or about August 15, 2019; and, 2) approved the renewal application on December 18, 2019.
- **Bronx Charter School for Better Learning**, an education corporation operating more than one school, sought to renew its authority to operate the following charter school:
 - **Bronx Charter School for Better Learning II**, located at 2545 Gunther Avenue, Bronx, NY 10469 in CSD 11, chartered to serve 375 students in grades K-4, sought a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2020. According to the renewal application, the school will grow to serve 456 students in grades K-5. The SUNY

Trustees: 1) received the renewal application on or about August 15, 2019; and, 2) approved the renewal application on December 18, 2019.

- **Explore Charter Schools of Brooklyn**, an education corporation operating more than one school, sought to renew its authority to operate the following charter schools:
 - **Explore Empower Charter School**, located at 188 Rochester Avenue, Brooklyn, NY 11213 in CSD 17, chartered to serve 540 students in grades K-8 sought a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2020. According to the renewal application, the school will continue to serve 540 students in grades K-8.
 - **Explore Exceed Charter School**, located at 443 St. Marks Avenue, Brooklyn, NY 11238 and 46 McKeever Place, Brooklyn, NY 11225, both in CSD 17, chartered to serve 564 students in grades K-8 sought a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2020. According to the renewal application the school will serve 576 students in grades K-8.

The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the renewal applications on or about August 15, 2019; and, 2) approved the renewal applications on December 18, 2019.

- **NYC Autism Charter Schools**, an education corporation operating more than one school, sought to renew its authority to operate the following charter school:
 - **NYC Autism Charter School East Harlem**, located at 433 East 100th Street, New York, NY 10029 in CSD 4, chartered to serve 40 students, sought a five year renewal of its charter commencing July 1, 2020. According to the renewal application, the school would continue to serve 40 students. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the renewal application on or about April 1, 2019; and, 2) approved the renewal application on October 15, 2019.
- **Success Academy Charter Schools – NYC**, an education corporation operating more than one school, sought to renew its authority to operate the following charter schools:
 - **Success Academy Charter School – Bed Stuy 2**, located at 211 Throop Avenue, Brooklyn, NY 11206 in CSD 14, chartered to serve 513 students in grades K-4 and 9-10 at the end of the current charter term, sought a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2022. According to the renewal application the school will serve 338 students in grades K-4.
 - **Success Academy Charter School – Bushwick**, located at 139 Menahan Street, Brooklyn, NY 11221 in CSD 32, chartered to serve 675 students in grades K-5 at the end of the current charter term, sought a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2021. According to the renewal application the school will serve 457 students in grades K-4.
 - **Success Academy Charter School – Cobble Hill**, located at 248 Baltic Street, Brooklyn, NY 11201 in CSD 15, chartered to serve 536 students in grades K-4, 9-10 at the end of the current charter term, sought a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2022. According to the renewal application the school will serve 340 students in grades K-4.

- **Success Academy Charter School – Far Rockaway**, located at 10-45 Nameoke Street, Queens, NY 11691 in CSD 27, chartered to serve 675 students in grades K-5 at the end of the current charter term, sought a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2021. According to the renewal application the school will serve 523 students in grades K-4.
- **Success Academy Charter School – Flatbush**, located at 15 Snyder Avenue, Brooklyn, NY 11226 in CSD 17, chartered to serve 675 students in grades K-5 at the end of the current charter term, sought a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2021. According to the renewal application the school will serve 454 students in grades K-4.
- **Success Academy Charter School – South Jamaica**, located at 120-27 141st Street, Queens, NY 11436 in CSD 27, chartered to serve 675 students in grades K-5 at the end of the current charter term, sought a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2021. According to the renewal application the school will grow to serve 871 students in grades K-8.
- **Success Academy Charter School – Williamsburg**, located at 183 South 3rd Street, Brooklyn, NY 11211 in CSD 14, chartered to serve 541 students in grades K-4 and 9-10 at the end of the current charter term, sought a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2022. According to the renewal application the school will serve 388 students in grades K-4.

The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the renewal applications on or about August 15, 2019; and, 2) approved the renewal applications on December 18, 2019.

- **Uncommon New York City Charter Schools**, an education corporation operating more than one school, sought to renew its authority to operate the following charter schools:
 - **Brooklyn East Collegiate Charter School**, located at 832 Marcy Ave., Brooklyn, NY 11216 in CSD 13, currently chartered to serve 345 students in grades 5-8 for the 2019-20 school year, the final year of the current charter term, sought a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2020. According to the renewal application, the school would grow to serve approximately 780 students in grades K-8.
 - **Kings Collegiate Charter School** (which includes “**Uncommon Leadership Charter High School**”), located at 905 Winthrop Street, Brooklyn, NY 11203, 1084 Lenox Road, Brooklyn, NY 11212, both in CSD 18 and 999 Jamaica Avenue, Brooklyn, NY 11208 in CSD 19, currently chartered to serve 1,396 students in grades K-12 for the 2021-22 school year, the final year of the current charter term, sought a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2022. According to the renewal application, the school would grow to serve approximately 1,458 students in grades K-12.
 - **Leadership Preparatory Bedford Stuyvesant Charter School** (which includes “**Uncommon Collegiate Charter High School**”), located at 141 Macon Street, 1st Floor, Brooklyn, NY 11216 and 832 Marcy Avenue, Brooklyn, NY 11216 both in CSD 13, currently chartered to serve 1,434 students in grades K-12 for the 2020-21 school year, the final year of the current charter term, sought a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2021. According to the renewal application, the school would grow to serve approximately 1,458 students in grades K-12.

- **Leadership Preparatory Brownsville Charter School**, located at 985 Rockaway Avenue, Brooklyn, NY 11212 and 213 Osborn Street, Brooklyn, NY 11212 both in CSD 23, currently chartered to serve 780 students in grades K-8 for the 2021-22 school year, the last year of the current charter term, sought a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2022. According to the renewal application, the school would continue to serve 780 students in grades K-8.
- **Leadership Preparatory Ocean Hill Charter School** (which includes “**Uncommon Preparatory Charter High School**”), located at 51 Christopher Avenue, Brooklyn, NY 11212 in CSD 23 and 6565 Flatlands Avenue, Brooklyn, NY 11236 in CSD 18, currently chartered to serve 1,383 students in grades K-12 for the 2019-20 school year, the final year of the current charter term, sought a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2020. According to the renewal application, the school would grow to serve 1,458 students in grades K-12.
- **Ocean Hill Collegiate Charter School**, located at 791 Empire Blvd., Brooklyn, NY 11213 in CSD 17 and 1137 Herkimer Street, Brooklyn, NY 11233 in CSD 23, currently chartered to serve 519 students in grades K-1, 5-8 for the 2019-20 school year, the final year of the current charter term, sought a five year renewal of its charter commencing August 1, 2020. According to the renewal application, the school would grow to serve 780 students in grades K-8.
- **Williamsburg Collegiate Charter School**, located at 157 Wilson Street, Brooklyn, NY 11211 in CSD 14, currently chartered to serve 345 students in grades 5-8 for the 2019-20 school year, the final year of the current charter term, sought a five year renewal of its charter commencing July 1, 2020. According to the renewal application the school would grow to serve 780 students in grades K-8.

The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the renewal applications on or about May 13, 2019; and, 2) approved the renewal applications on October 15, 2019.

Please take further Notice that the SUNY Trustees will send the proposed renewal charter(s) to the New York State Board of Regents for approval or action consistent with the New York Charter Schools Act of 1998.
