**SUBJECT: Final Notice of Charter Revision(s) – Operation of Law**

**DATE: September 6, 2018**

This third and final Notice, pursuant to New York Education Law § 2857(1), is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as charter authorizer, approved revision(s) for the charter school(s) listed below, sent the revision(s) to the New York State Board of Regents ("Board of Regents"), and the revision(s) has been approved by operation of law or by the Board of Regents in accordance with the New York Charter Schools Act of 1998 (as amended the "Act"). As the Act requires no further action, this will be the last notice on this item. A description of the revision(s) is as follows:

**Ascend Charter Schools**, an education corporation with the authority to operate more than one school, has requested enrollment revisions at two of its schools as follows:

- **Brooklyn Ascend Charter School**, located at 205 Rockaway Parkway, Brooklyn, NY 11212; 123 East 98<sup>th</sup> Street, Brooklyn, NY 11212, both in New York City Community School District ("CSD") 18; and, 1501 Pitkin Avenue, Brooklyn, NY 11212 in CSD 23, currently authorized to serve 1,277 students in grades K-11, requests an enrollment increase to serve 1,376 students in grades K-11 for the 2017-18 school year, the final year of the current charter term. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the revision application on or about November 10, 2017; 2) approved it on January 9, 2018; and, 3) the revision was approved by operation of law on July 30, 2018.
- **Brownsville Ascend Charter School**, located at 1501 Pitkin Avenue, Brooklyn, NY 11212 in CSD 23, currently authorized to serve 1,073 students in grades K-9, requests an enrollment decrease to serve 1,028 students in grades K-8 for the 2017-18 school year and 1,020 students in grades K-8 for the remainder of the charter term. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the revision application on or about November 10, 2017; 2) approved it on January 9, 2018; and, 3) the revision was approved by operation of law on July 30, 2018.
