**SUBJECT: Final Notice of Charter Revision(s) – Operation of Law**

**DATE: September 6, 2018**

This third and final Notice, pursuant to New York Education Law § 2857(1), is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the “SUNY Trustees”), in its capacity as charter authorizer, approved revision(s) for the charter school(s) listed below, sent the revision(s) to the New York State Board of Regents (“Board of Regents”), and the revision(s) has been approved by operation of law or by the Board of Regents in accordance with the New York Charter Schools Act of 1998 (as amended the “Act”). As the Act requires no further action, this will be the last notice on this item. A description of the revision(s) is as follows:

- **Rochester Preparatory Charter School 3**, located at 85 St. Jacob Street, Rochester, New York 14621 in the Rochester City School District, originally approved to serve 167 students in grades 5-6 for the 2017-18 school year, seeks to revise its enrollment to serve approximately 180 students in grades K-1 for the 2017-18 school year. The school had originally been approved to serve 576 students in grades K-2 and 5-8 by the end of the current charter term. The request provides for the school to serve approximately 630 students in grades K-6 by the end of the current charter term. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the request for revision on or about November 30, 2017; 2) approved the revision on April 24, 2018; and, 3) the revision was approved by operation of law on August 16, 2018.
