This Notice is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, has received an application to revise the charter(s) of the charter school(s) listed below. Further, the SUNY Trustees, or their designees, the SUNY Charter Schools Committee or SUNY Charter Schools Institute (the "Institute"), anticipate consideration of this request as soon February 11, 2020. A description of the proposed action follows:

- **The Academy Charter School**, an education corporation with the authority to operate two schools has requested the following revision to one of those schools:
 - **The Academy Charter School – Uniondale**, located at 100 Charles Lindbergh Boulevard, Uniondale, New York 11553 in the Uniondale Union Free School District, is authorized to serve 249 students in grades K-3 for the 2019-20 school year and grow to 475 students in grades K-6 by the 2022-23 school year, the last year of the current charter term. The school seeks to add a vocational high school program beginning in the 2020-21 school year initially serving 125 students in grade 9 and growing to serve an additional 375 students in grades 9-11 by the 2022-23 school year, the last year of the current charter term. Accordingly, the resulting total enrollment would be 450 in 2020-21 and growing to 850 in 2022-23.
