This Notice is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, has received applications to revise the charter(s) of the charter school(s) listed below. Further, the SUNY Trustees, or their designees, the SUNY Charter Schools Committee or SUNY Charter Schools Institute (the "Institute"), anticipate consideration of this request as soon February 16, 2017.

A description of the proposed actions follows:

Bronx Preparatory Charter School, a charter school education corporation authorized by SUNY, and located at 3872 Third Avenue, Bronx, NY 10457 in Community School District ("CSD") 9, seeks to merge with the following education corporations:

- **Harlem Prep Charter School**, authorized by SUNY, and located at 240 East 123rd Street, New York, NY 10035 and 410 East 100th Street, New York, NY 10029 in CSD 4;
- **Democracy Preparatory Charter School**, authorized by New York City Schools Chancellor, and located at 2230 5th Avenue, New York, NY 10037 and 222 West 134th Street, New York, NY 10030 in CSD 5;
- **Democracy Prep Harlem Charter School**, authorized by the New York City Schools Chancellor, and located at 207 West 133rd Street, New York, NY 10030, 212 West 120th Street, New York, NY 10027 and 2005 Madison Avenue, New York, NY 10035 in CSD 5; and,
- **Democracy Prep Endurance Charter School**, authorized by New York State Board of Regents, and located at 250 West 127th Street, New York, NY and 240 East 123rd Street, 2nd Floor, New York, NY 10035 in CSD 5;

such that when the merger is approved, Bronx Preparatory Charter School would be the successor education corporation under the name “**Democracy Prep New York Charter Schools.**”
