- **Green Tech High Charter School**, located at 99 Slingerlands Street, Albany, New York 12202 in the Albany City School District, currently serving approximately 360 students in grades 9-12, requests to add a middle school program beginning in the 2018-19 school year with approximately 40 students in grade 6 and growing by one grade each year. At full capacity, the school would serve approximately 495 students in grades 6-12.
