This Notice is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, has received an application to revise the charter of the charter school listed below. Further, the SUNY Trustees, or their designees, the SUNY Charter Schools Committee or SUNY Charter Schools Institute (the "Institute"), anticipate consideration of this request as soon as February 16, 2017.

A description of the proposed action follows:

- **True North Troy Preparatory Charter School**, located at 2 Polk Street, Troy, NY 12180 in the Troy City School District, currently serving approximately 515 students in grades K-8, requests to revise their admissions policy so that its at-risk admissions factors, or "preferences," include a 20% set-aside for English Language Learners for incoming students.
