This updated Notice is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the “SUNY Trustees”), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, approved the revision(s) to the charter(s) of the charter school(s) listed below.

A description of the proposed action(s) follows:

- **Invictus Preparatory Charter School**, located at 370 Fountain Avenue, Brooklyn, NY, 11208, in Community School District (“CSD”) 19, currently approved to serve approximately 342 students in grades 5-8, requested to decrease enrollment to 290 students in grades 5-8 for the 2017-18 school year and to 275 students in grades 5-8 for the 2018-19 school year, the final year of the current charter term. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the revision application on or about October 20, 2017; and, 2) approved it on December 12, 2017.
- **UFT Charter School**, located at 800 Van Siclen Avenue, Brooklyn, New York 11207, in CSD 19, currently approved to serve 410 students in grades 9-12 for the 2017-18 school year requested to decrease enrollment to 320 students in grades 9-12 for the 2017-18 school year, the final year of the current charter term. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the revision application on or about October 20, 2017; and, 2) approved it on December 12, 2017.

Please take further Notice that the SUNY Trustees have sent or will send the proposed revision(s) to the Board of Regents for approval or action consistent with the New York Charter Schools Act of 1998.
