This updated Notice is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, approved the revision(s) to the charter(s) of the charter school(s) listed below.

A description of the proposed action(s) follows:

- **The Academy Charter School**, located at 117 North Franklin Street, 159 North Franklin Street, and 94 Fulton Avenue, Hempstead, New York 11550, in the Hempstead Union Free School District, currently approved to serve approximately 925 students in grades K-10, has requested to increase enrollment to 1134 students in grades K-10 for the 2017-18 school year, and to 1296 students in grades K-11 for the 2018-19 school year, the final year of the current charter term. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the revision application on or about November 2, 2017, and; 2) approved it on December 12, 2017.

Please take further Notice that the SUNY Trustees have sent or will send the proposed revision(s) to the Board of Regents for approval or action consistent with the New York Charter Schools Act of 1998.
