This updated Notice is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the “SUNY Trustees”), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, approved the revision(s) to the charter(s) of the charter school(s) listed below.

A description of the proposed action(s) follows:

- **KIPP Tech Valley Charter School**, located at 321 Northern Blvd., Albany, New York 12210 in the Albany City School District, originally approved to serve 543 students in grades K-2 and 5-8 for the 2017-18 school year, seeks to revise its enrollment to serve approximately 511 students in grades K-1 and 5-8 for the 2017-18 school year. The school had originally been approved to serve 667 students in grades K-8 by the end of the current charter term in 2019-20. The revision request provides for the school to serve approximately 693 students in grades K-3, and 5-8 by the end of the current charter term. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the revision application on or about October 26, 2017; and, 2) approved it on December 12, 2017.

Please take further Notice that the SUNY Trustees have sent or will send the proposed revision(s) to the Board of Regents for approval or action consistent with the New York Charter Schools Act of 1998.
