This first Notice, pursuant to New York Education Law § 2857(1), is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, has received the following charter revision request(s):

- **Achievement First Brooklyn Charter Schools**, an education corporation with the authority to operate more than one school, has been approved to reconfigure the enrollment at several schools to allow for clear pathways into already approved and established high school programs, and has requested additional changes as follows:
 - **Achievement First Bushwick Charter School**, located at 125 Covert Street, Brooklyn, NY 11207 and 1300 Greene Avenue, Brooklyn, NY 11237, in Community School District ("CSD") 32, currently approved to serve approximately 964 students in grades K-12, has requested to decrease enrollment to 824 students in grades K-8 for the 2017-18 school year and the 2018-19 school year, the final year of the current charter term. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the request for revision on or about March 15, 2018; and, 2) approved the revision on April 24, 2018.
 - **Achievement First Voyager Charter School**, located 601 Parkside Avenue, Brooklyn, NY 11226 in CSD 17, currently authorized to serve 276 students in grades 5-7 for the 2018-19 school year, seeks to increase enrollment to serve 366 students in grades K and 5-7 for the 2018-19 school year growing to 710 students in grades K-2 and 5-9 in the 2020-21 school year, the final year of the current charter term. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the request for revision on or about March 15, 2018; and, 2) approved the revision on April 24, 2018.

- **Harlem Village Academy Charter School**, located at 74 West 124th Street, New York, NY 10027 and 244 West 144th Street, New York, NY 10030, in CSD 5, currently authorized to serve 950 students in grades K-12, requests to change its name to **Harlem Village Academy West Charter School**. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the request for revision on or about March 15, 2018; and, 2) approved the revision on April 24, 2018.
- **Harlem Village Academy Leadership Charter School**, located at 2351 First Avenue, New York, New York 10035 and 35 West 124th Street, New York, NY 10027, in CSD 4, currently authorized to serve 990 students in grades K-12, requests to change its name to **Harlem Village Academy East Charter School**. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the request for revision on or about March 15, 2018; and, 2) approved the revision on April 24, 2018.
- **International Leadership Charter School**, located at 3030 Riverdale Avenue, Bronx, NY 10463 in CSD 10, currently authorized to serve 410 students in grades 9-12, requests an enrollment decrease to serve 343 students in grades 9-12 for the 2017-18 school year, 380 students in grades 9-12 for the 2018-19 school year, and 410 students in grades 9-12 for the 2019-20 school year, the final year of the current charter term. In addition, the school requests to change its name to **International Leadership Charter High School**. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the request for revision on or about March 15, 2018; and, 2) approved the revision on April 24, 2018.
- **New York Autism Charter Schools**, an education corporation with the authority to operate more than one school, has requested an enrollment revision as follows:
 - **New York Center for Autism Charter School Bronx**, located at 977 Fox Street, Bronx, NY 10459, in CSD 7, currently authorized to serve 24 students in the 2018-19 school year, requests to serve 20 students. The school would serve 32 students for the remainder of the charter term as originally approved. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the request for revision on or about March 15, 2018; and, 2) approved the revision on April 24, 2018.

Please take further Notice that the SUNY Trustees have or will send the proposed revision(s) to the New York State Board of Regents for approval or action consistent with the New York Charter Schools Act of 1998 (as amended).
