**SUBJECT: Second Notice of Charter Revision(s) – SUNY Trustee Approval**

**DATE: December 7, 2017**

This updated Notice is to inform you that the State University of New York Board of Trustees (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, approved the revision(s) to the charter(s) of the charter school(s) listed below.

A description of the proposed action(s) follows:

- **Achievement First Brooklyn Charter Schools**, an education corporation with the authority to operate more than one school, has requested to reconfigure the enrollment at several schools to allow for clear pathways into already approved and established high school programs:
  - **Achievement First Brownsville Charter School**, located at 2021 Bergen Street, Brooklyn NY in Community School District ("CSD") 23, has requested to increase enrollment in the 2017-18 school year, the last year of the current charter term, from 933 students in grades K-10 to 1004 students in grades K-10. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the revision application on or about July 28, 2017; and, 2) approved it on October 11, 2017.
  - **Achievement First Crown Heights Charter School**, located at 790 East NY Avenue, Brooklyn, NY in CSD 17, has requested to increase enrollment in the 2017-18 school year, the last year of the current charter term, from 966 students in grades K-12 to 1304 students in grades K-12. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the revision application on or about July 28, 2017; and, 2) approved it on October 11, 2017.

- **Achievement First East New York Charter School**, located at 557 Pennsylvania Avenue, Brooklyn, NY and 158 Richmond Street, Brooklyn NY, both in CSD 19, has requested to increase enrollment from 1064 students in grades K-12 to 1190 students in grades K-12 for the remainder of the current charter term. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the revision application on or about July 28, 2017; and, 2) approved it on October 11, 2017.
  - **Achievement First Endeavor Charter School**, located at 510 Waverly Avenue, Brooklyn, NY in CSD 13, scheduled to serve 997 students in grades K-12 in the 2017-18 school year shall only serve 757 students in grades K-8 for the remainder of the charter term. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the revision application on or about July 28, 2017; and, 2) approved it on October 11, 2017.
  - **Achievement First Voyager Charter School**, located at 15 Snyder Avenue, Brooklyn, NY in CSD 17, has requested to decrease enrollment in the 2017-18 school year from 250 students in grades 5-6 to 184 students in grades 5-6 for a total of 618 students in grades 5-9 by the end of the current charter term. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the revision application on or about July 28, 2017; and, 2) approved it on October 11, 2017.
- **Amber Charter School**, an education corporation with the authority to operate more than one school, has requested to increase the enrollment of **Amber Charter School II**, located at 3120 Corlear Avenue, Bronx, NY in CSD 10 from 120 students in grade 1-2 to 230 students in grades K-2 for the 2017-18 school year for a total of 475 students in grades K-5 by the end of the current charter term. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the revision application on or about July 28, 2017; and, 2) approved it on October 11, 2017.
  - **Bronx Charter School for Excellence**, an education corporation with the authority to operate more than one school, has requested to increase the enrollment of **Bronx Charter School for Excellence 3**, located at 1804 Holland Avenue, Bronx, NY in CSD 10, scheduled to serve approximately 120 students in grades K-1 to 180 students in grades K-1 for a total of 540 students by the end of the current charter term. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the revision application on or about July 28, 2017; and, 2) approved it on October 11, 2017.

Please take further Notice that the SUNY Trustees have sent or will send the proposed revision(s) to the Board of Regents for approval or action consistent with the New York Charter Schools Act of 1998.
