SUBJECT: Second Notice of Charter Revision(s) - Approval

This updated Notice, pursuant to Education Law § 2857(1), is to inform you that the Board of Trustees of the State University of New York (the "SUNY Trustees"), in its capacity as a charter authorizer, approved revision(s) of the charter(s) of the charter school(s) listed below. A description of the proposed actions follows:

- **Brooklyn Emerging Leaders Academy Charter School**, located at 125 Stuyvesant Avenue, Brooklyn, NY in Community School District ("CSD") 16, currently authorized to serve approximately 100 students in grade 9 for the 2017-18 school year and to grow to 371 students in grades 9-12 by the end of the current charter term, requests to decrease its enrollment to 85 students in grade 9 for the 2017-18 school year to grow to 314 students in grades 9-12 by the end of the current charter term. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the revision application on or about May 1, 2018; and, 2) approved the request on June 6, 2018.
- **Brooklyn Prospect Charter School**, an education corporation with the authority to operate more than one school: **Brooklyn Prospect Charter School – CSD 13** located at 80 Willoughby Street, Brooklyn, NY in CSD 13 and **Brooklyn Prospect Charter School – CSD 15** located at 3002 Fort Hamilton Parkway, Brooklyn, NY in CSD 15, has requested to enter into an agreement with a new charter management organization, Prospect Schools, Inc., to provide certain educational and operational services. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the revision application on or about May 1, 2018; and, 2) approved the request on June 6, 2018.

- **Cypress Hills Ascend Charter School (formerly Central Brooklyn Ascend Charter School 2)**, to be located at 396 Grant Avenue, Brooklyn, NY in CSD 19, currently authorized to serve approximately 224 students in grades K-1 for the 2018-19 school year requests an enrollment decrease to 166 students in grades K-1 for the 2018-19 school year growing to serve 498 students in grades K-5 by the 2022-23 school year, the last year of the current charter term. The SUNY Trustees: 1) received the revision application on or about May 1, 2018; and, 2) approved the request on June 6, 2018.

- **Family Life Academy Charter Schools**, an education corporation with the authority to operate more than one school, requested enrollment revisions for the following schools. For each revision, the SUNY Trustees: 1) received the revision application on or about May 4, 2018; and, 2) approved the request on June 6, 2018.
 - **Family Life Academy Charter School**, located at 14 West 170th Street, Bronx, NY in CSD 9, currently authorized to serve approximately 416 students in grades K-5 for the 2018-19 school year requests an enrollment decrease to 286 students in grades K-5 for the 2018-19 school year; and,
 - **Family Life Academy Charter School III**, located at 370 Gerard Avenue, Bronx, NY in CSD 7, currently authorized to serve approximately 312 students in grades K-4 for the 2018-19 school year requests an enrollment decrease to 250 students in grades K-4 for the 2018-19 school year.

Please take further Notice that the SUNY Trustees have or will send the proposed revision to the New York State Board of Regents for approval or action consistent with the New York Charter Schools Act of 1998 (as amended).
